Do you favor authorizing the board of directors of School Administrative District No. 75 (the "District") to issue bonds and notes and other evidences of indebtedness in the name of the District in an amount not to exceed \$102,100 through the State of Maine's zero interest rate/ loan forgiveness School Revolving Renovation Fund (SRRF) Program for installation of a fully accessible ADA-compliant restroom at Bowdoin Central School (the "Project")?

A. Project Explanation: The Project involves renovating a storage space at Bowdoin Central School into a fully accessible restroom that is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Project will enable the District to provide private, functional and safe restroom facilities for special education students with complex needs.

B. Financing Explanation: The Project costs up to a maximum of \$102,100 have been approved for funding through Maine's zero interest rate/loan forgiveness SRRF Program. Of this amount, the District will receive 54.24% (up to \$55,379) that will be forgiven, and 45.76% (up to \$46,721) that the District will repay at zero interest (0%) over a term of five years.
